The “Enrica Lexie” Incident

At the request of the President, I wish to inform you that Judge Cot would like to address to you the following question. You may wish to answer during the hearing of today or at the latest by Wednesday, 12 August 2015, noon.

On behalf of Italy, Sir Daniel Bethlehem proposed to transform the surety of 300.000 euros in respect of each of the marines “through some appropriate arrangement into a surety given to India in accordance with the stipulations if an order of this Tribunal” (ITLOS/PV.15/A24/1, p. 46).

Could Italy be more specific as to the proposal?
