THE TRIBUNAL WILL PARTICIPATE IN HAMBURG'S LONG NIGHT OF THE CONSULATES ON 9 MAY 2023

The International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea will participate in the Long Night of the Consulates on Tuesday, 9 May 2023. On that day, from 5:30 p.m. to 9 p.m., the general public will have the opportunity to visit the headquarters building in Hamburg (Nienstedten) and learn about the work of the Tribunal.



Members of the public will have access to the building, the courtroom complex and the restored nineteenth-century Villa Schröder. Presentations about the Tribunal's work will be held in English, German and French for those who wish to have more detailed information on the work of the Tribunal. The Tribunal will be open to visitors from 5:30 p.m. with final entry at 8.30 p.m. Visitors are required to provide valid photo-identification upon entry to the venue.

The Tribunal is located at Am Internationalen Seegerichtshof 1 and may be reached via public transport using the S-Bahn (S1) to Klein Flottbek or by bus (112) to Elbschlossstraße.
